ENHANCED Smart911

Smart911 is a **free** service that allows individuals & families to sign up online to provide key information to 911 call takers in an emergency. Smart911 saves critical time and has proven to save lives nationwide. The

additional information provided in a Smart911 Safety Profile enables responders to know exactly where they are going & who they are looking for in a house fire or at the scene of a vehicle accident. Those details can help responders act quicker & more efficiently. The Safety Profile travels with you and the additional information provided allows the call center to send the right response teams faster. With Smart911, citizens can link both home & work addresses to mobile phones, which can be passed on to responders in the field for a more detailed, rapid response. The

benefits of this information on a 9-1-1 call from a cell phone is immeasurable. Mobile phones do not provide an address to the 9-1-1 call taker. These emergency situations are often the worst time of a person's life & the Safety Profile can speak for you when you might not be able to.

Smart 911 has been credited with positively impacting emergency outcomes including a missing child in which the girl's photo & physical description were immediately available.
